Dear parent/carer, learner.

I hope you are all safe and well and have enjoyed as much as possible the sunny weather over the weekend. Please see update 2 from the Prime Ministers speech on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May. Government guidelines are now suggesting that year 1(10) may return on the 15<sup>th</sup> June for face to face contact, please see the table below for our plan for return and how this will look from a learner perspective.

Your son or daughter will be grouped according to transport needs and previous banding and is not negotiable due to Bus times, delivery teams, all learners that are on site will be expected to wear Academy uniform and conform to all Health and Safety procedures and social distancing measure. All learners will receive a full induction onto the site, on their first morning back with us, this induction will outline all health and safety measures each learner will be expected to adhere to alongside a full outline of the subjects to be covered over the remainder of the year. I have briefly outlined some of these measures below.

Each group will contain around 10-12 students at any one time with breaks and lunches staggered to reduce contact with other groups of learners while adhering to social distancing measures and all Health and Safety requirements. Learners should bring a packed lunch and enough drinks to last throughout the day. Where learners have received free school meals this will continue. Please ensure that you bring your own sun cream (not to be shared) as we may eat lunch outside when the weather permits. Hand sanitiser and washing facilities will be available in all four classrooms in use and learners will be always be based in the same classroom reducing the need to walk around the building. Learners will receive 6 days in The Academy until the academic year ends as the whole year group will be delivered to in this way. The group you are allocated to will remain your group until we break for the summer.
